1. ONA Board

- a. No names were submitted in order to put together a ballot.

- c. Two hit and runs on Argonne recently. Neighbor asked that the board write a letter to our city Council members to have a study conducted. Cameras have just been added to The Alameda as a result of a previous study. The board will write a letter.
